Central States Water Environment Association, which is comprised of water pollution control facilities managers, consulting engineers, regulatory agency personnel, and educational personnel, invites you to participate in the 79th Annual Conference to be held May 8-11, 2006 at the Pheasant Run Resort and Convention Center, St. Charles, IL.

The CSWEA Annual Meeting provides an excellent opportunity for your organization to market your products and/or services to decision makers involved in all facets of the water pollution control field.

The exhibits will be open on Tuesday, May 9, 2006 from 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and Wednesday May 10, from 9:00 am to Noon. The Pheasant Run Expo Center offers space for hundreds of 8' x 10' booths, plus plenty of room for tables to accommodate lunch and social sessions. Easy access is provided for large vehicles and equipment displays.

To ensure maximum attendance in the exhibit hall, we are offering:

- Lunch for all attendees to be served in the back of the exhibit hall on Tuesday.
- Conference break session refreshments served only in the exhibit hall.
- Free Exhibitor's Reception gathering in the exhibit hall between 4:00 and 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday with complimentary wine, beer, soft drinks and hors d'oeuvres.
- Committee and special events to be held in Expo Sky-Boxes, to keep folks in the exhibit area.
- Door prizes awarded only if winner is on the exhibit floor.

The exhibit registration will include:

- Two Exhibit registrations, which includes:
 - Monday Meeting & Greet
 - Monday & Tuesday exhibit sessions
 - Exhibit area lunch and Exhibitor's Reception
- Exhibit pipe & drapery, 8' skirted table, 2 chairs, and a wastebasket

COST. The cost for an 8' x 10' exhibit space is \$500.00 if the application is postmarked prior to April 8, 2006 and \$550.00 for booth applications postmarked after April 8, 2006. Each additional contiguous 8' x 10' exhibit space is available at the discounted rate of \$250.00 each prior to April 8, and \$300.00 each after April 8, 2006. (must be contiguous)

Additional Exhibit-Only Registration. Additional exhibit-only passes can be purchased for exhibitors desiring more than two members per booth. The cost for the Exhibitor Exhibit-Only pass is \$70.00 and includes the exhibit lunch, Exhibitor's Reception. You MUST purchase these passes and note the person's name on your registration form to have more than two persons at your booth.

Electrical Cost. There is an additional fee for electrical hookup: \$80.00 for an 110V, 20 amp connection. Exhibitors requiring electricity for their booth need to identify this on their registration form and include this cost with payment.

Attendee Exhibit-Only Registration. This year's conference will also provide the opportunity for you to provide client's entrance to the exhibits without having to attend/pay for the full day's conference activities. This is a great opportunity for water quality professionals in the near-area that only have a portion of the day and/or only want to attend the exhibit session. This pass costs \$10 and covers the lunch and Exhibitor's Reception. Expo only passes include only those events held in the Expo Hall. The registration form includes a line item for this Attendee Exhibit-Only pass. You will be asked to provide names for the pass recipients on a follow-up confirmation sheet. The exhibit-only attendees will check in at the registration desk and receive their name tag, which is also proof of conference registration.

Confirmation Packet. Please note that upon receipt of your exhibit registration, a confirmation packet will be sent in early May. Included in this will be the full-conference registration packet for completion of optional items such as banquet meal type, golf, and walk/run. It will be necessary to register for the Technical Programs, Banquet and other conference programs when the 79th Annual Meeting Conference Registration Package is available. On-line registration for exhibitors and conference registration will also be available at www.CSWEA.org.

The application DEADLINE is April 17, 2006. Please get your application and rental fee in early and save money!
