RE: Illinois Section Trustee Report
Date: October 5, 2007

The following is a summary of Illinois Section activities since the May 2007 CSWEA Annual Meeting at the Monona Terrace in Madison, WI.

1. The Illinois Section Operations Quick Talks were held on August 29, 2007 at the Urbana-Champaign Sanitary District's Southwest Plant. The event had 47 attendees, including eight speakers. The event resulted in a gross income of \$1,617.86 and expenses of \$ 516.18, for a net income of \$ 1,101.68.
2. The Illinois Section held a Laboratory Workshop on June 20, 2007 at the Marriott Courtyard in Warrenville, IL. The event had 24 attendees, with speakers from Hach and Idexx each giving two-hour presentations. Even though the event resulted in a net loss of \$ 226.90, positive feedback was received about continuing the workshop in the future.
3. An Illinois Section meeting was held in early August 2007 in Warrenville, IL to discuss the year's upcoming events. Rich Hussey and Lee Melcher will co-chair the Young Professionals group, and are in contact with the Illinois Water Environment Association (IWEA) and the Illinois AWWA to plan joint social functions. Also discussed was the possibility of changing the term "Quick Talks" to "Seminar".
4. A Fall Quick Talks / Maintenance and Safety Seminar is scheduled for November 15, 2007 to be hosted by the City of Naperville, at their Safety and Training Center. At the conclusion of the seminar a facility tour is scheduled. This is the second year for this event by the Illinois Section. The event was organized by the Safety Committee Chair, Gary Scott from the Glenbard Wastewater Authority.
5. A planning meeting for the annual "Government Affairs in Water Pollution Control" is scheduled for October 26, 2007. This event is co-sponsored with the Illinois Water Environment Association (IWEA). The conference usually takes

- place at the Wyndham Hotel in Lisle, IL in January. This conference not only provides an opportunity to get together with our fellow members and learn about what is “coming down the pipe” in the way of regulation, but also encourages a cooperative relationship between our organizations. Illinois Section officers plan on attending the meeting.
6. Members of the Illinois Section attended and participated in the Committee and Section Exchange (CSX) meeting on July 19 & 20, 2007 at the Kalahari in Wisconsin Dells. The CSX provides an opportunity for the State Section Officers and Committee heads and the Executive Committee to exchange ideas and information between the various groups.
