

# Planes, Ponds and Pints

Ever wonder how stormwater is handled at the Minneapolis St. Paul International Airport? Get a behind-the-scenes look at stormwater, snow management and operations at the 16th largest airport in the county. This tour will explore the airport's stormwater management as it relates to snow removal, aircraft deicing fluid collection and management, and stormwater conveyance.

After a 30-minute information session, tour stops will include:

- MAC's Field Maintenance shop, to view state-of-the-art snow management equipment that is critical to efficient airport operations and removing snow precipitation from the airfield
- One of MSP's dedicated deicing pads, where aircraft are deiced and impacted stormwater is collected
- MSP's Glycol Management Facility, where collected stormwater is recycled and treated
- Airport stormwater ponds

Following the tour, the group will meet up at Town Hall Lanes to enjoy a cold beverage and snacks.
