Join the Minnesota Stormwater Committee as we tour stormwater and watershed improvements along Bassett Creek. You'll participate in a guided 1-mile walk in the largest and wildest park in Minneapolis. Highlights include:

- Streambank restoration project at historic Fruen Mill (photo above)
- A flood control project
- A unique outlet that helped get Wirth Lake off the MPCA's impaired waters list (photo at right)
- Planned lagoon dredging of contaminated sediments (a complex permitting and cultural resources project)
- Many historical features, including from the Works Progress Administration era

The tour will start at Utepils Brewery. Following the tour, at 5:00 p.m., we will enjoy a happy hour at the Utepils biergarten along the bank of the creek. This event and tour will happen rain or shine, so please dress for the weather.
