We are excited to announce the 37th annual Conference on the Environment (COE) will be held on **Thursday, November 10, 2022**, at the Minneapolis Convention Center. We invite you to apply to present at the COE by submitting a presentation summary online by **Friday, September 16<sup>th</sup>**.

The 2022 Conference on the Environment offers concurrent technical sessions of specific topics associated with water, air, and waste management issues. The conference is co-hosted by the Central States Water Environment Association (CSWEA) and the Air and Waste Management Association (AWMA), Upper Midwest Section (UMS). To receive consideration, presentation summaries must be submitted online. **Deadline for submittal is September 16<sup>th</sup>**. Submissions should include a very brief discussion (less than 500 words) of the proposed topic to present. Presentations will be 25 minutes in length, including time for questions and answers; however, a few double sessions of 50-55 minutes will be available for presenters who have extensive material to cover. No formal paper is required. If this presentation has been previously

presented, please provide details on the conference such as its name, date, and location.

Final selection of the presentations will be based on the presentation content and on its fit with other selected presentations to create well-rounded, informative technical sessions.
