CSWEA/IAFSM will host a three-day PCSWMM training course in person on July 26-28 in Schaumburg, IL. Attendees need to bring a laptop and will receive a trial license of the software. There are limited spots available.

This course will provide attendees a comprehensive overview of the capabilities of PCSWMM, covering software basics as well as advanced topics. Attendees will gain an understanding of data requirements, model development, computational methods of the software, and interpreting results for a variety of applications. Training topics will include modeling of stormwater systems, low impact development (LID), water quality, combined sewer systems, and wastewater collection systems. It will also cover 1D-2D integration, pump station applications, calibration, pre- and post-processing tools, and troubleshooting. Each participant will get hands-on experience working through examples with the help of experienced instructors.

This training follows the IAFSM publication of **Hydrologic and Hydraulic Model Review: A Review and Assessment of Software for Illinois Practitioners** in March of this year, which rated PCSWMM as one of the top hydrologic and hydraulic modeling software programs available for urban stormwater analysis.
