



Biking, Brews, and the MVPs of BMPs

Target Field, 1 Twins Way, Minneapolis

Meet at Gate 29, off North 7th Street, between the Twins Team Store and the box office. Several bike racks are located along the stadium on North 7th Street, underneath the Ramp A – Skyway.

Did you know that Target Field Station was built with several features that capture, clean and reuse stormwater runoff? Come enjoy a guided walking tour of the sustainable innovations Target Field is using followed by a bike ride exploring other stormwater BMPs and landscape designs in Downtown Minneapolis. Some highlights will be:

- **Target Field:** Prepare to learn about the system they use to irrigate their field and wash the stands using recycled rainwater. Also find out how they melt snow without using salt or deicing chemicals in an effort to reduce river pollution.
- **Elliot Park Skate Plaza:** See the features that capture and treat polluted runoff on site, as well as provide pollinator habitat in tandem with a state-of-the-art skate park, created by the design team for the skate park at the Tokyo Olympics.

The guided walking tour of Target Field begins at 3:15 p.m., but plan to arrive at 3 p.m. Please bring your own bike and helmet. **Cost of the tour is \$25.** If you have any questions about the tour, please contact Bridget Osborn at bosborn@hrgreen.com.
